Jo Cox's poignant last words as she lay dying in the street after being shot were: *'I can't make it, I'm in too much pain.'*

They were revealed yesterday by the MP's assistant Fazila Aswat, who had just dropped her off outside her constituency surgery.

She also described the agony of Mrs Cox's husband Brendan over how to break the news of the tragedy to their two young children, pleading to the aide: *'What am I going to tell them?'*

Struggling to understand what had happened as she saw the MP lying bloodied on the ground, Miss Aswat, 38, swung her handbag at the attacker, begging Mrs Cox: *'Come on Jo, get up.'*

This was when the 41-year-old MP spoke her last words.

Her attacker then shot Mrs Cox twice more as she lay prone and fled, according to witnesses. She was pronounced dead around an hour later.

Miss Aswat, who had worked for the MP for a year, is too distressed to speak publicly, but the horrifying detail of the attack was given yesterday by her father, former Labour Councillor Ghulam Maniyar, 59.

He told the Daily Mail his daughter had just driven Mrs Cox from Batley, West Yorkshire, to nearby Birstall, where she was about to hold her constituency surgery on Thursday.

The MP left the car first, and when Miss Aswat followed her shortly afterwards she was confronted by a horrific scene.

'When she came out to the other side (of the car) she saw Jo lying on the floor, full of blood,' Mr Maniyar said.

'She was in shock. When she saw the blood, she tried to help. And she says: "Come on Jo, get up."

'And Jo said – these are the last words she spoke to my daughter – she said: "I can't make it, I'm in too much pain."'

The above account brought an overwhelming sense of emotion to the whole of the country.

But there is also anger from a minority of people who sense something is not right. Anger not just at the mindless attacker who is still unrepentant in his actions, but an anger against the invisible shadowy elite who we believe used Jo's life as the sacrifice needed to fulfil another agenda.

The timing of this tragic event just at the point when there was a national sentiment that the "BREXIT" campaign was starting to move away from the "REMAIN" campaign, has been described as immaculate timing.

AFTERMATH OF THE TRAGEDY

Vigils have been held across the UK after the killing of the Batley and Spen MP Jo Cox on Thursday. The leaders of the Labour and Conservative parties stood together in the West Yorkshire town of Birstall to pay tribute to her.



The prime minister said he first met Cox, who became an MP in 2015, in 2006 when she was working with refugees in Darfur, Sudan. He called her “one of our most compassionate campaigners.”

Cameron said today was a day to “*stand back and think about what we treasure. One of those is having MPs available to the public,*” adding that “*we should recognize that politicians are there to serve the public.*” Corbyn said that the killing was “*a tragedy beyond tragedy.*”



The Labour leader also praised the statement given by Cox’s husband Brendan shortly after she was killed in which he said:

“*Jo believed in a better world and she fought for it every day of her life with an energy and a zest for life that would exhaust most people.*”


It also emerged that Barack Obama had contacted Cox’s bereaved husband Brendan to pass on the condolences of the American people.

THE FAR RIGHT CONNECTION

The media and police are now stating that neo-Nazi literature was found at the home of Tommy Mair, the man suspected of killing Cox, police said that his apparent links to far-right groups would form a “priority line of inquiry”. Officers said they would also look into supposed claims surrounding his mental health.

In a statement released shortly before 1am on Saturday, Det Supt Nick Wallen, who is leading the investigation, said:

“We have now charged a man with murder, grievous bodily harm, possession of a firearm with intent to commit an indictable offence and possession of an offensive weapon.”



Appearing before Westminster Magistrates Court on Saturday Thomas Mair gave his name as “*Death to traitors, freedom for Britain*”.

This follows on from the media claiming that as he committed his murder he shouted to Jo “*Put Britain First*” something which supposed witnesses have since denied.

In a further indication of far-right reaction to the murder of Jo Cox, journalist Mark Townsend reports that another Yorkshire MP received a death threat for sympathising with refugees the day before Jo Cox was murdered.

Notts Casual Infidels, a far-right group belonging to the extremist Infidels network, posted an image of York Central Labour MP Rachael Maskell addressing a “refugees welcome rally” at 9.39am on Thursday 15 June with the warning: “*This b*tch needs to disappear.*”

Hours after Cox's death later that day, the same group said in a Facebook post: "We knew it was only a matter of time before we take it to the next level. We have been mugged off for Far too (sic) long." The post was later deleted.

That follows the news that police are investigating a white supremacist group after applause for the killing was posted on one of its social media accounts.


According to the anti-fascist group *Hope Not Hate*, at least nine MPs have been targeted by far-right activists during the past two years.



Special police units who searched the house of Thomas Mair are believed to have found samples of Nazi regalia and far-right literature.

Thomas Mair was also known to have bought books from a US-based neo-Nazi group, including guides on how to build homemade guns and explosives, according to an anti-hate campaign group in the US. Among them was a manual on how to make a homemade pistol.

In the US, the *Southern Poverty Law Center* (SPLC) published receipts that appeared to show Mair bought, among other books, a manual on how to make a homemade pistol from the *National Alliance*.



The receipts, some of which date back to the 1990s, showed Mair spent more than \$620 (£436) on literature from the group, which advocates the creation of an all-white homeland and the eradication of Jewish people.

He bought books that instructed readers on the "chemistry of powder and explosives", "incendiaries", and a work called *Improvised Munitions Handbook*. The handbook included detailed instructions on constructing a pipe pistol using parts available in DIY stores.

Received items also included *Ich Kämpfe*, an illustrated handbook issued to members of the Nazi party in 1942.

There were also reports that Mair was named as a subscriber to *SA Patriot*, a South African magazine published by *White Rhino Club*, a pro-apartheid group.

The club describes the magazine's editorial stance as being opposed to "multicultural societies" and "expansionist Islam".

DANIEL BAILEY'S EMAIL

The Brexit Referendum will be held on June 23, and British MP Jo Cox, a staunch anti-Brexit proponent, was shot and killed by a man with psychological issues and who happened to shout "*Britain First*" just before the murder.

The sentiments of Daniel Bailey has been echoed by many. The timing of the cold-blooded murder of liberal British lawmaker Jo Cox, as she was going to a meeting with constituents Thursday, has led to a flurry of social-media chatter claiming Cox's killing was plotted by forces seeking to sway next week's referendum in favor of Britain remaining in the European Union.

This view has been widely circulating on social media and underscores the increasingly heated debate over Britain's future in the EU. Much like American voters who have rallied behind presumptive Republican presidential candidate Donald Trump, supporters of the so-called Brexit are being labelled by the "Remain" campaign as immigrant-wary nationalists who are dissatisfied with establishment politicians and with a dangerous far right influence.

However it is the timing of this tragedy which has sparked significant debate.

Up until last Thursday

"Britain's "Leave" campaign opened up a 7-point lead over "Remain" ahead of a referendum on membership of the European Union an opinion poll showed late Monday, while the nation's biggest-selling newspaper urged readers to vote to quit the bloc.

The result of the June 23 referendum will have far-reaching consequences for politics, the economy, defense, migration and diplomacy in Britain and elsewhere. Recent polls are suggesting that momentum has swung towards the "Leave" camp, or a so called Brexit, unsettling investors. "Leave" in recent days has focused its campaign on the issue of immigration.

According to the YouGov poll for The Times, "Leave" held 46 percent support compared with 39 percent support for "Remain." Undecided voters were 11 percent, while 4 percent won't vote. Bloomberg tracker indicates 3.3% lead for Leave EU campaign, while the Rothschild's Economist gave it a statistical tie."

Markets can appear callous. On Thursday, the pound and euro rallied sharply, while gold and government bonds sold off after the killing of British lawmaker Jo Cox. Even talking about this link will make some people angry, either with me or with investors who seem to be trying to profit from a tragedy. Two young children have been left without a mother and Parliament has lost one of its rising stars.

But one of the points of markets is that they are amoral. Not immoral—although much of the wrongdoing uncovered after the financial crisis certainly was—but unconcerned with morality at all. They are deliberately unfeeling, heartless and unsympathetic, because they exist to balance out millions of individual views in order to allocate capital and assess risk.

There is no way to be sure what was on the minds of all those who traded on Thursday, but that balance looked pitiless to the point of cruelty. Markets had fallen sharply in the morning as worries about a possible British exit from the European Union, or “Brexit,” intensified. They had already bounced a little from their low before reports trickled in about the attack and both sides in the campaign suspended operations. But the pound and euro really took off, and gold fell as much as \$23, after police announced Ms. Cox was dead.

The unsympathetic bet is that her death will convince more of Britain’s voters to stick with Europe, helping avoid the Brexit investors fear. Ms. Cox had been campaigning against Brexit, and on Wednesday her family took to a dinghy in the Thames to confront a pro-Brexit flotilla sailing through London. Rumors circulated that the referendum itself might be postponed.

Ms. Cox may become a symbol for the remain campaign, or may not, but markets typically react first and worry later. With the pound up more than 2 cents against the dollar from its low to its high, it looks as though the collective wisdom of the market is that Ms. Cox’s death will play a significant role in the campaign.

Consider what happened when stock markets were reopened a week after the Sept. 11 attacks in the U.S. in 2001. Investors made a series of calculated, rational and extremely insensitive assessments: airline stocks immediately tumbled by a third, while shares in big defense companies jumped more than a 10th.

Tragic events prompt emotional responses from us, and so they should. But markets should not be criticized for coldly reflecting available information as they try to assess the state of the world; indeed, two of the major barriers to perfect markets identified by academics are emotional decisions by investors who often fail to assess all the information.

However, the individuals making up the markets need to remember their basic humanity while making those calculations, whether about a tragedy in a far-off land or one closer to home.

It reflects a dramatic six-point turnaround since a similar Survation poll on Thursday, hours before the Labour MP was killed. The new telephone poll was conducted on Friday and Saturday as the nation mourned Mrs Cox.

The six-point switch confirms claims by some commentators that voters could take a more 'risk-averse' approach to leaving the EU so soon after Mrs Cox's shocking death.

Survation's Thursday poll showed Leave on 45 and Remain on 42, the exact reverse of today's figures. The number of undecided – 13 per cent – has stayed the same. If undecided voters are excluded, the poll produces a 52-48 per cent majority in favour of staying in the EU."


